Our Purpose: to protect adults with care and support needs who are at risk of abuse or neglect, and to promote their well-being, dignity, and safety. The Board provides strategic leadership, oversight, and challenge to ensure that safeguarding arrangements are effective, personcentred, and continuously improving.

Key Statistics:

- 10 SAR referrals (3 commissioned, 7 did not meet threshold)
- 161 SAR actions tracked, 68% discharged
- In Adult Social Care: 93% risks reduced or removed, 89% outcomes achieved
