Who are we?

Bury Safeguarding Adults Board (BSAB) helps keep adults safe from harm, abuse and neglects.



We work with many organisations, like the police, the council, NHS and charities.

We make sure adults who need help and care are protected.



Together we:

- Check how well services are working
- Learn from mistakes
- Share good ideas
- Help people speak up



What Happened This Year?

Our main goals:

- Make sure services are delivered well for adults
- Improve on safeguarding
- Learn from mistakes



Listening to People

We have talked with people who have support and people who help them to make sure we are a good service



What the Numbers Say

- People were asked about how they wanted to be worked with
- Risks were reduced or removed for adults



The most common types of abuse were:

- Neglect
- Financial
- Psychological



Mental Capacity

Some people could not make decisions for themselves.

We worked with families and carers to help keep them safe. We trained staff to work better with them.



Safeguarding Adult Reviews (SARs)

We look at cases when something goes wrong. This year we looked at 3 cases.



What We've Done to Improve

- Trained staff
- Learned from our reviews
- Included people in our reviews

Who We Work With

- Bury Council – Adult Social Care
- NHS, hospitals and GP surgeries
- Police, probation and fire services
- Adult learning and charities





Money and Resources

We received £135,297 to spend this year. Most of this was spent on staff, reviews and training for staff.

For the next year we are focusing on:

- Listening more to our community
- Looking more into our learning impact
- Making safeguarding personal
- Improving what we do
- Improving safeguarding as young people become adults
- Improving our services at the highest level
